Around the World in Eighty Days is an adventure story by the French writer Jules Verne. In the story, the hero, Phileas Fogg, must travel around the world in 80 days. 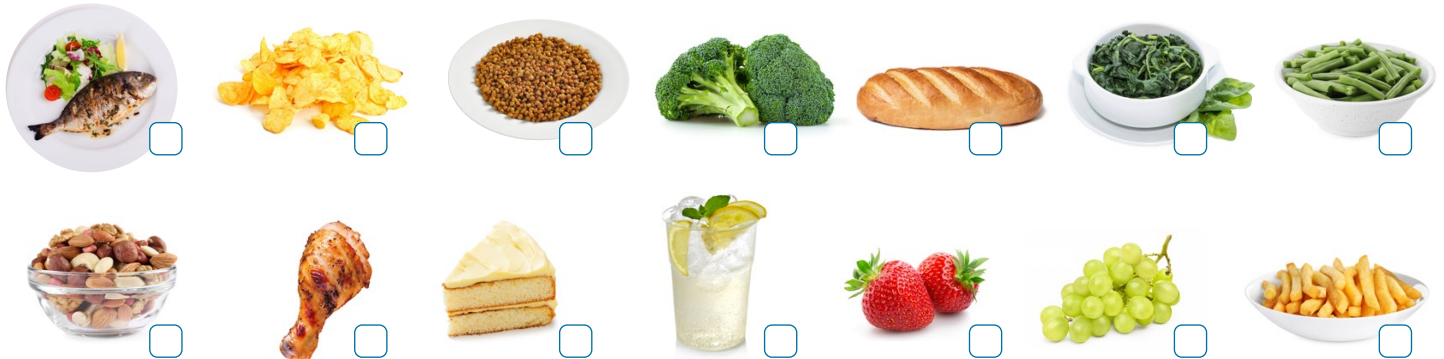
