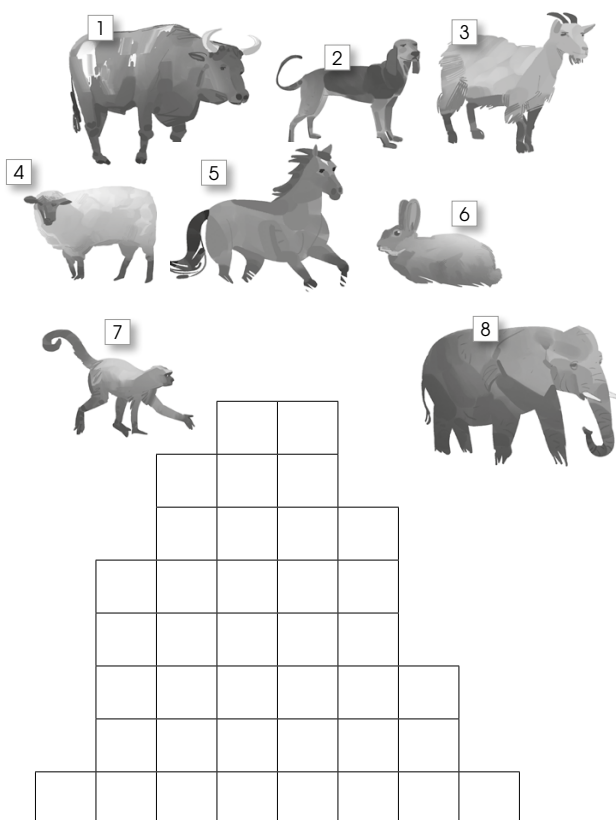

How a man bought a ticket to space

On 28th April, 2001, Dennis Tito went into space. But he wasn't an astronaut, he was the first space tourist in the world.

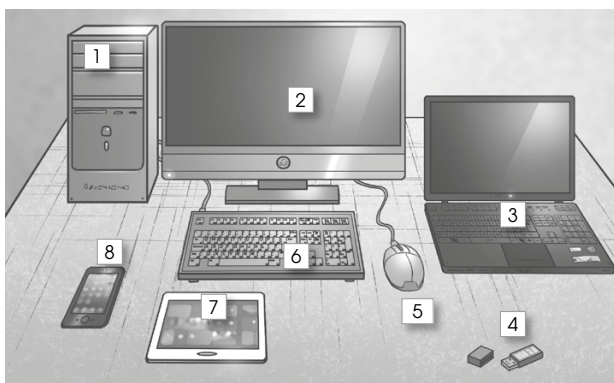
