- The present simple positive for *I, you, we* and *they* is the same as the base form.
I go to college.
We live here.
They wake up at six.
- Add an -s for *he, she* and *it*.
I write → *She writes*
We work → *It works*
- Some verbs are irregular. For *he, she* and *it*, we change the ending.

Irregular verbs	
verbs ending in o	add -es
verbs ending in y	take off the y and add -ies

go *I go / You go / We go / They go*
 He / She / It goes

do *I do / You do / We do / They do*
 He / She / It does

study *I study / You study / We study / They study*
 He / She / It studies

cry *I cry / You cry / We cry / They cry*
 He / She / It cries

*She **doesn't do** her homework in her living room.*

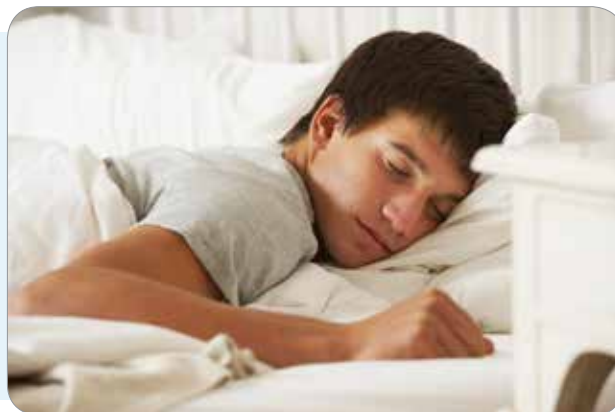
