## The Earth is My Mother

The point of departure for *The Earth is My Mother* is a motif from a Navajo Indian song [2], which the composer employs to develop further powerful elements. They in turn combine with recited text [7] and archaic drum rhythms [6] to form a highly expressive composition.

**Rehearsal note:**

Choral performance of this piece starts with a warm-up section comprising elements 1 – 6, which are to be performed accompanied by rhythmical body movements. Together with an emotional focus on the theme of the piece, these vocal/body warm-ups are the key to an expressive interpretation.
